When my husband Dan and I take our winter trip to South Florida, we drive three days each way. It helps in winding down from work, and then getting ready again. This year, I felt motion sick the middle day both ways of driving.

We stopped at a truck stop to use the facilities and I picked up a pack of mint gum to settle my stomach. When we paid for it, the cashier said something that I didn't understand. I asked her to repeat it. She had

asked if I wanted the gum in my purse instead of in a bag (which I did).

I laughed. What I heard was something about the gum and prayer. I said some silly things about praying over the gum, or using the gum in prayer. And then I quieted, took a more serious tone, and asked her if she would like me to pray for her. Since I thought she said "Prayer," maybe she could use a prayer. She said no, but thanked me for the offer.

On our way to the car, I told Dan that she probably thought I was the weirdest customer of the day. Dan replied that he thought I made her day. He said the look on her face changed, and that she felt cared for, even though we didn't pray.

Reflecting on that interaction, I wonder how often we see someone just doing their job, and how often we see a person. For that moment, I saw the image of God in her. I don't take the little bit of time that takes very often. I wonder if you do.

What difference could we make in our little circle of influence if every time we interacted with someone, we took the extra few seconds to see the image of God within them? How could doing this bring some much-needed joy into the world? How much light could we bring if we did this?

I think God has great things in store for us, individually, and as a church, to partner with God in building God's Kingdom on earth as it is in heaven. Little things like this make such a difference.



LOOSE COINS

Meals on Wheels



March is the month for Madness, along with spring fever and unpredictable weather, but at the River of Life it's also about Meals.

Our March Loose Coins will go to **Beloit Meals on Wheels**. This amazing, literally volunteer-driven organization delivers daily nutritious meals to the homebound elderly, ill, and disabled. Clients can choose to receive a hot noon meal, and optionally supper, either 5-days or 7-days per week, including holidays. For many it's the only social contact of the day, and it can be an important safety check.

Did you know:

- •76% of clients are 70 years or older
- •79% live at very low to extremely low income levels
- •32% are veterans or spouses of veterans
- •63,877 meals were delivered in 2023
- •306 homebound seniors were served

Funding for Meals on Wheels comes from community donations, federal and state program funds, and client contributions. Those unable to pay the full cost are encouraged to make a contribution, but no one is denied service due to inability to pay.

reminder that it is through the grace of Jesus Christ that we are able to be made right with God, and have eternal life, for this life, and the life to come.


Fresh Flowers for the Sanctuary
