You never know how wonderfully God works through people until there is a crisis.

The Monday of Vacation Bible School there was a tornado warning about a half hour before VBS was done for the night. When the siren went off, adults quickly looked to see if the warning was real, then how far away the storm was. As I was ready to suggest where leaders take their children, Karen came to me, and we quickly decided where the children should go. In that short 30 seconds or less,

the leaders were already taking their children to places that were safe. Several leaders even thought quickly enough to take things with them to do. Some children were afraid, and adults were comforting them. (Of those, several were more afraid for their parents at home than for themselves.) I heard adults reassuring children, and one even matter-of-factly said, "No, the tornado is not near us, but we are following the rules." I sat down (in the men's bathroom!) with one of the groups of kids and had some wonderful conversation about their science projects of the evening. Karen brought around more snacks. When parents arrived to pick up their children, they found their children calm and in safe places. I even heard one boy say, "I don't want to go yet, we're not done!"

This was not school where we had practiced tornado drills. Although some of our leaders are or have been teachers, others have not. I didn't have to tell leaders where to go or what to do. Perhaps even more importantly, I didn't have to tell them how to witness to the love of God in the midst of everything. They just did.

I don't know why I continue to be amazed by this congregation. God is certainly working within you in so many ways! Continue to fill yourselves with the love and light of God. You will continue to be the love of God for others!

I'll see you in church, where we continue to love others into taking their next step with Jesus.

We will soon be beginning MCCI, the Missional Church Consultation Initiative. It is an honor and a privilege as Churches must be invited into this process. Churches must be healthy and must want to grow in following Jesus Christ. This process has been wonderful in the West Ohio Annual Conference, with 300 churches participating. We are one of only six churches that has been invited into the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the process in Wisconsin. It is a privilege and responsibility.

### During our time in MCCI:

- •Pastor Brenda will attend a monthly training for a year.
- •Pastor Brenda will bring what she learned back and share it with our MCCI Team.
- •After 6-8 months, Scott Carlson, Wisconsin Conference Director of Congregational Development and Sue Nilson Kibbey, Director of Missional Church Initiatives for the West Ohio Annual Conference and also the co-author of the Dynamite Prayer book we read, will come to spend an entire day with us, meeting with individuals and small groups, listening to what we love about our church and listening to our hopes and dreams for our church.
- •Based on our unique situation, Scott and Sue will create a Prescription for us, to help us become all we believe God is calling us to be.
- •We will have a Charge Conference where we will decide to implement the Prescriptions, or exit the MCCI process.
- •Should we decide to implement, we will be assigned coaches unique to our situation to help us in that implementation.

We will contribute \$2,500 to this process. The average church receives \$12-15,000 in coaching and other resources.

### How can you participate?

- •We need an MCCI Team to meet with Pastor during the first year. It would be helpful to have older and younger people, longer and shorter length members on this team. Connect with Pastor Brenda if you would like to be on this exciting team.
- Everyone needs to participate in our day with our consultants in 6-8 months.



### Rice Meal Pack

Pastor Mike Weigand, who served First Church in downtown Beloit, is now at Sugar River UMC in Verona. #### LOOSE COINS



September Loose Coin offerings will go to **Midwest Mission Distribution Center (MMDC).** Midwest Mission is close to our hearts in this church because it is where our adult mission trips go. Volunteers work on Personal Dignity Kits, School Kits, Cleaning Kits, bicycle repair, building school desks....all to benefit people here and abroad who are suffering from the immediate or long-term effects of disasters.

Our volunteers love to work at

Midwest Mission because it is such a God-focused ministry. Every kit placed in a box is prayed over by the volunteer who prepared it. A completed pallet of Cleaning Kits (flood buckets) is prayed over by those who packed them. Every truck loaded with requested supplies is sent out with a prayer circle.



We work hard at Midwest Mission, but

we also love to hear the miracle stories, often told at our break times, of how God is at work there. Here is one story from a couple years ago:



Midwest Mission received a request for a huge shipment of rice meal bags for Ukraine. Churches and on-site teams worked hard to complete the 48,000 rice meal bags to fill a shipping container that would be shipped in just two weeks. During that time, Executive Director Chantel Corrie related, "Southern Baptist"

Disaster Relief dropped off some emergency blankets, gloves, and baby supplies that they didn't need. Before the driver had even left the lot, Operation Ukraine called looking for blankets and baby supplies." Then, there was a request for medical supplies for Ukraine, and Midwest Mission promptly got a call to come and pick up surplus supplies from a VA hospital. It all went out with the shipping container of food. These miracle stories are common, of an "ask" coinciding with a donation offer. As Chantel says, "God orchestrates it all."

It gives us workers the clear sense that we're doing God's work, and we are where we're supposed to be.

It's the spirit that drove Diane Gemignani and Sarah Parsons to explore getting a loom for our church to begin doing the new ministry of making plastic-bag sleeping mats. Sarah said, "I'll just buy one," and now we have a dedicated team coming in every week to learn the steps and work on the mats.



If you would like to be part of any of this work and fellowship, you can join the loom workers on alternate Wednesdays and Fridays, or join the group going to a rice meal pack at Rev. Mike Weigand's church in Verona on Sept. 7, or sign up for the next adult mission trip to Midwest Mission the week of March 23, 2025, with options to go for the whole week or just the traditional three days. More details are found elsewhere in The Current.
